Report unsafe food vendors

▶ Protect your health. Eat safe food! ◀

Street vendors are an important part of our community, but eating food from an **unpermitted vendor** can put you and your family's health at risk.



Know how to spot unsafe, unpermitted food vendors.

- ✗ No handwashing on-site
- ✗ Poor hygiene
- ✗ No refrigeration to keep food cold
- ✗ Food cross-contamination
- ✗ Vermin and insects
- ✗ Lack of food safety training
- ✗ Food from unknown sources
- ✗ No restrooms
- ✗ Food exposed and unprotected
- ✗ No decal or Health Permit

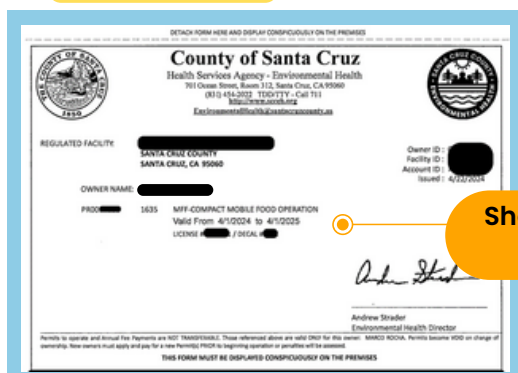


Unsafe food can affect a person or an entire community, making them sick, possibly resulting in loss of work, hospitalization, or death.
