- 2016 Electronic Annual Reports
 - o Overdue, submit ASAP if you have not already!
 - Enforcement and fees are forthcoming
- Lead Service Line Inventory
 - Requirement for Community Water Systems (CWSs) only
 - Water system responsibilities extend to the meter, but if you become aware of lead lines or other issues beyond the meter, you should inform the homeowner
 - o Identification of lead lines or possible lead lines must be completed by July 1st, 2018

- Applies to all Public Water Systems (Community, Nontransient Noncommunity, and Transient Noncommunity)
- Federal RTCR finalized in 2016, California RTCR still in development
- Context
